Rules

- Teams shall consist of two players.
- Any Lodge or Chapter in the Province of Middlesex may enter one or more teams.
- The matches must be played by the dates shown in the draw, which will be advised to the entrants during April 2008.
- 1st Round 1st Named are the Challengers, 2nd Round 2nd named are the Challengers, and then alternating thereafter. The Challengers' responsibilities are to select the course, give the opponents at least three alternative dates and it is expected that all participants shall share the cost.
- The final must be played at neutral course.
- The format of the matches will be four-ball better ball match play, with three quarters of the difference in handicap. And all matches shall be played to their conclusion including extra holes.
- All matches shall be played in strict accordance with R & A rules. Stroke allowance shall be taken against a maximum of 24. Players not having a handicap at a recognised golf club shall play off a maximum of 18.
- If a team fails to arrange a match or shall fail to attend at the time and place agreed by their opponents that shall be deemed to have withdrawn and its opponents shall be given a walk over.
- A Substitute is allowed in the event of a team member having to withdraw from any round and who has not previously played for another team in this year's competition. The substitute must be from the same Lodge or Chapter.
- All players must be fully paid up members of the MMGS.
- The entry fee is £10 payable to the MMGS.
- Once a round has been played the Secretary must be notified.
- The Trophy will be presented at the MMSA dinner, which will be held 31 October 2008 by which time all matches must have been completed.
- In the event of any dispute or differences the Secretary shall decide by reference to the Rules of the R & A. The Secretary's decision in all matters, is final.
- All entrants shall enjoy the competition.
